PROCION MX DYES**Quick Start Colors - the very least you need**

Small containers are ok to get started

- Yellow MX-8G
- Red MX-8B
- Turquoise MX-G
- Black (any type of black is suitable)

Additional Colors - expand your color options

These additional dyes, plus the ones above, are a complete list of the dyes that I use to create my colors.

These additional dyes will be needed if you would like to recreate the dye recipes that I share in class.

- Yellow MX-3R
- Red MX-5B
- Red MX-GBA
- Blue MX-G
- Blue MX-2G
- Blue MX-R
- Violet MX-2R
- Orange MX-2R
- Indigo (optional)

CHEMICALS AND SUPPLIES

- Soda Ash
- Synthrapol or original Dawn dishwashing liquid

SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- Dust Mask or Respirator
- Rubber Gloves
